Sub: Organization of District Level Children's Science Congress-2019

Dear Sir/Madam

This is with reference to the letter no. SSA/MC/2019/185332 dated 02.07.2019 from DGSE, Punjab vide which you have been nominated to act as the District Coordinator for organizing Children's Science Congress in your district.

As you are aware, the National Children's Science Congress (NCSC) is a countrywide program which provides the children of 10 to 17 years from all over the country to prepare small research projects under the guidance of a teacher. The objective of the program is to inculcate scientific temper among children and make them learn scientific methodology. Each year, various schools participate at the District Level and then the selected projects from the districts participate at the State Level. Finally, 16 projects are selected from the State for participation in the National Level Congress.

Further, as per the approval of DGSE, the DEO's (Secondary Education) in all districts will act as a District Coordinators of CSC in their respective districts to organize CSC at the District Level. The role and responsibilities of District Coordinator under CSC would be as under:

- 1) To agree in writing on being selected as District Coordinator of CSC to abide by rules and regulations prescribed under program guidelines of CSC and also by State Organizing Committee (SOC).
- 2) To constitute a District Organizing Committee (DOC) & District Academic Committee (DAC) comprising not less than 7 teachers/activists/ex-child scientists/officials and send the list to State Organizing Committee (SOC).
- 3) To register CSC Groups (2 children and 1 guide teacher per group) in Form-A and provide them necessary reference material, kits and guidance.
- 4) To organize Orientation Workshops for guide teachers and evaluators.
