## Office of the District Magistrate-Cum-Deputy Commissioner, Mansa. (Misc. Branch) ORDER

In continuation of this office order No. 8272-8303/MA/MC-1 dated 7.05.2021 considering the COVID-19 situation in the district following restrictions are hereby imposed with effect from 16.05.2021 to 31.05.2021:-

- Daily Night Curfew from 6:00 PM to 5:00 AM and Weekend Curfew from 6:00 PM on Friday up to 5:00 AM on Monday throughout the District strictly prohibiting all the non-essential activities; but all essential activities including those enumerated hereinafter in the paragraph 2 titled "Exemptions" to continue to remain exempted from curfew restrictions.
- 2. Nobody to enter in Mansa whether by air, rail or road without either
  - a) Negative Covid report not more than 72 hours old, or
  - b) Vaccination certificate (at least one dose) over 2 weeks old.
- 3. Number in public transport (buses, taxis, autos) to be restricted to 50% of the capacity.
- All Bars, Cinema Halls, Gyms, Spas, Swimming Pools, Coaching Centres, Sports Complexes to remain closed.
- 5. Shops in the Mansa District will be open as per following schedule :-

- Whole sale Sabji Mandi & Fruit Mandi in the district will be closed by 10:00 AM positively.
- II No rehries are allowed to park at any particular place and they should have to sell the Fruits/ Sabji by moving around the streets up to 5:00 PM.
- III Milk Dairy, Milk vendors can open for home delivery from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM.
- All restaurants (including in hotels), Cafes, Coffee Shops, Fast Food Outlets, Dhabas etc.
  to remain closed for dine-in and no take-away. Home delivery allowed till 7:00 PM. No
  seating inside Restaurants, Fast Food joint, Coffee Shops etc. to be allowed.
- 7. All Weekly markets (such as Apni Mandis) to be closed.
- 8. There shall be a complete ban on all Social, Cultural or Sports gatherings and related functions.
- Persons who have attended large gatherings anywhere (Religious/Political/Social) to be mandatorily home quarantined for 5 days and tested as per protocol.
- All private offices, including service industry, such as offices of Architects, Charted Accountants, Insurance Companies etc. allowed to Work from Home only.
- The Banking Business hours for all the Bank Branches in the District Mansa, Monday to Saturday from 10.00 AM to 2.00 PM. with 50% of the employees.
- All Four-Wheeler passenger vehicles, including cars and taxis, not allowed to seat more than 2 passengers, vehicles carrying patients to hospitals exempted, No pillion riders on

scooters and motorcycles except those belonging to the same family and living in the same house, reserve at Petrol Purrps, Malls (Supermarket) six

- Religious places to be closed at 6:00 PM daily. No overcrowding at Gurudwaras, Mandirs, 13. Masjids, Churches etc. where Supertwine Vendors such as Reducing the second pro-
- Villages will organise Thikri Pehras to ensure that 'Night Curfew' and Weekend Curfew' 14. orders are compiled with. The Colleges may continue to rangin open
- No gathering of people more than 10 to be allowed; including for weddings/cremations/ 15. funerals. Jonday to Friend but Abutas not a open.
- There shall be a complete ban across the District in all political gatherings. 16.
- Persons who have attended large gatherings anywhere (Religious/Political/Social) to be 17. mandatorily home quarantined for 5 days and tested as per protocol.
- All Educational Institutions i.e. Schools and Colleges to remain closed, staff of Govt. 18. Schools to attend duty.
- Union and Religious leaders not to be hold gathering and restrict number of protesters to 19. taken presence at Petrol Pumps, Malls (Supermarket) etc.
- Action will be taken against those hoarding Oxygen Cylinders etc. 20.
- RT-PCR testing of Road and Streetwise Vendors, such as Rehriwallas etc. will be carried 21. out. Traffic Police and Medical Teams to co-ordinate for testing.
- All the Medical and Nursing Colleges may continue to remain open.
- Retail and Whole Sale Liquor Vendors in the district will be open from 9.00 AM to 5.00 22. 23. PM on Monday to Friday but Ahatas not to open.

## **Exemptions:**

The following activities/establishments shall, subject however to observing COVID-19 appropriate behaviour by all concerned, remain exempted from COVID -19 restrictions above :-

- Hospitals, Veterinary Hospitals and all establishments both in public and private sector related to manufacture and supply of all medicines and medical equipments. 1. Transportation of all personnel of these establishments shall be allowed subject however to production of identity cards.
- E-commerce and movement of all goods. 2.
- Construction activities in both Urban and Rural areas.
- Agricultural including Procurement, Horticultural, Animal Husbandry and Veterinary 3. 4.
- Activities of manufacturing industry and services given below including movement of all their employees/workers and vehicles carrying them upon production of requisite 5. permission from their employers:-
- Telecommunication, Internet Services, Broadcasting and Cable Services. IT and IT
- Petrol Pumps and Petroleum Products, LPG, Petroleum and Gas Retail and Storage
- Power Generation, Transmission and Distribution Units and Services.
- Cold Storage and Warehousing Services.



All Banking/RBI services, ATMs, Cash Vans and Cash Handling/ Distribution Services. There shall be strict implementation of all the extant directives of MHA/State Government on COVID-19 appropriate behaviour including social distancing norm of minimum 6 feet distance (2 Gaz Ki Doori), regulating crowds in market places and public transport and imposition of penalties prescribed for violation of COVID-19 appropriate behaviour like wearing of face masks and spitting in public places etc. Any violation of these guidelines shall be punishable under Section 51 to 60 of Disaster

Management Act, 2005 besides legal action under Section 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC).
