11.32 AM	Address by Smt Vini Mahajan, Chief Secretary.
11.35 AM	Address by Sh Anurag Agarwal, ACS Home and presentation of a short video on efforts against drugs.
11.45 AM	Address by Sh Dinkar Gupta, DGP.
11.50 AM	Address by Dr Sukhchain Singh Gill, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar on the procedure for the destruction of seized drugs.
11.55 AM	Address by Speaker 1 (Girl Student, Live from Rural School in Doaba).
11.57 AM	Address by Speaker 2 (Male Rehabilitated Addict, Live from Rural area in Malwa).
11.59 AM	Address by Speaker 3 (Lady School Teacher, Live from Urban School in Majha).
12.01 PM	Address by Speaker 4 (Member Nasha Nigran Committee, Live from Village in Malwa).

2. The Department of Home Affairs & Justice shall be the Nodal Department for the event and all expenditure, including the cost of Advertisement to appear in the newspapers, shall also be borne by it.

3. Sh. Rahul Tiwari, IAS, Nodal Officer, Anti-Drug Campaign, shall be the Nodal Officer for the event. Additional Chief Secretary Home Affairs & Justice is Anti-Drug Campaign.

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- 4. The event shall be simultaneously telecast through VC in all District & Sub-Divisional Headquarters, all State & Private Universities and about 4000 Rural and Urban locations presided over by Hon'ble Speaker/Deputy Speaker/ Ministers/ MPs/ MLAs/ Vice-Chancellors/ DCs/ SDMs/ Mayors/ Principals/ Chairpersons and Members of Zila Parishads & Panchayat Samitis/Sarpanches in the respective VC locations.
- Nodal Officer, Anti-Drug Campaign, is requested to finalise the selection of Speakers 1-5 in the above schedule in consultation with Principal Secretary Health & Family Welfare, Principal Secretary Higher Education and Secretary School Education. Principal Secretary Health & Family Welfare, Principal Secretary Higher Education and Secretary School Education are requested to facilitate. Nodal Officer Anti-Drug Campaign is also requested to provide these speakers with different topics to speak on.
- 6. Secretary School Education is requested to operationalise and make available all the existing VC facilities in 4000 urban and rural Government Schools for the event.
- 7. Nodal Officer, Anti-Drug Campaign, is requested to finalise the list of VC locations in consultation with Secretary School Education and convey these to Deputy Commissioners, Chief Minister's Secretary and Pol Secy -1/CM by 24.6.2021 so that the attendance of dignitaries at each of these locations can be planned.
- 8. Principal Secretary Higher Education is requested to facilitate the presence of at least 25 students (part of Buddy Program) in each VC location (University).
- 9. Secretary School Education is requested to facilitate the presence of 25 students (part of Buddy Program) in each VC location (school).
- 10. Secretary School Education is requested to facilitate the presence of 12-13 Teachers (part of Buddy Program) in each VC location (school).
- 11. Nodal Officer, Anti-Drug Campaign, is requested to coordinate the presence of about 12-13 Nasha Nigran Committee Members at each VC location. All Deputy Commissioners are requested to facilitate.
- 12. Financial Commissioner Rural Development & Panchayats is requested to facilitate the presence of Sarpanches/Panchayat Members in each rural VC location.
- 13. Principal Secretary Local Government is requested to facilitate the presence of Mayors/President MCs/Councillors in each urban location.
- 14. Pol Secy-1/CM is requested to coordinate the attendance of Hon'ble Speaker/Deputy Speaker/Ministers/ MPs/ MLAs/ Vice-Chancellors/ DCs/ SDMs/ Mayors/ Principals/ Chairpersons and Members of Zila Parishads & Panchayat Samitis/Sarpanches at various locations. WEARING OF MASK AND SOCIAL DISTANCING SHOULD BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO AT EACH VC LOCATION.
- 15. Additional Chief Secretary Home Affairs & Justice is requested to prepare a short video on the efforts of the State in combating the menace of drugs, which shall be shown during the event. Nodal Officer, Anti-Drug Campaign, and Director Information & Public Relations are requested to extend all assistance.

- 16. Principal Secretary Higher Education is requested to finalise the contours of the One-Week State-wide Awareness Drive through University/College students in consultation with Higher Education Minister and implement the same.
- 17. Secretary School Education is requested to finalise the contours of the One-Week State-wide Awareness Drive through schools students in consultation with Education Minister and implement the same.
- 18. Director Information & Public Relations is requested to finalise the design of the Backdrop and Standees for the event and share these with the Nodal Officer, Anti-Drug Campaign. The Department of Home Affairs & Justice shall ensure that these are adequately placed at various VC locations.
- 19. Director Information & Public Relations is requested to record the testimonials and pictures of participants at each VC location in LANDSCAPE mode and maintain these for PR purposes in future.
- 20. Director Information & Public Relations is requested to ensure live telecast and adequate publicity of the event in the print, electronic and web media.
- 21. Director Governance Reforms is requested to facilitate the VC link and conduct a dry run at least a day before the event.
- 22. Deputy Commissioners are requested to facilitate and operationalise the events at all locations.
