Jang-e-Azadi Memorial



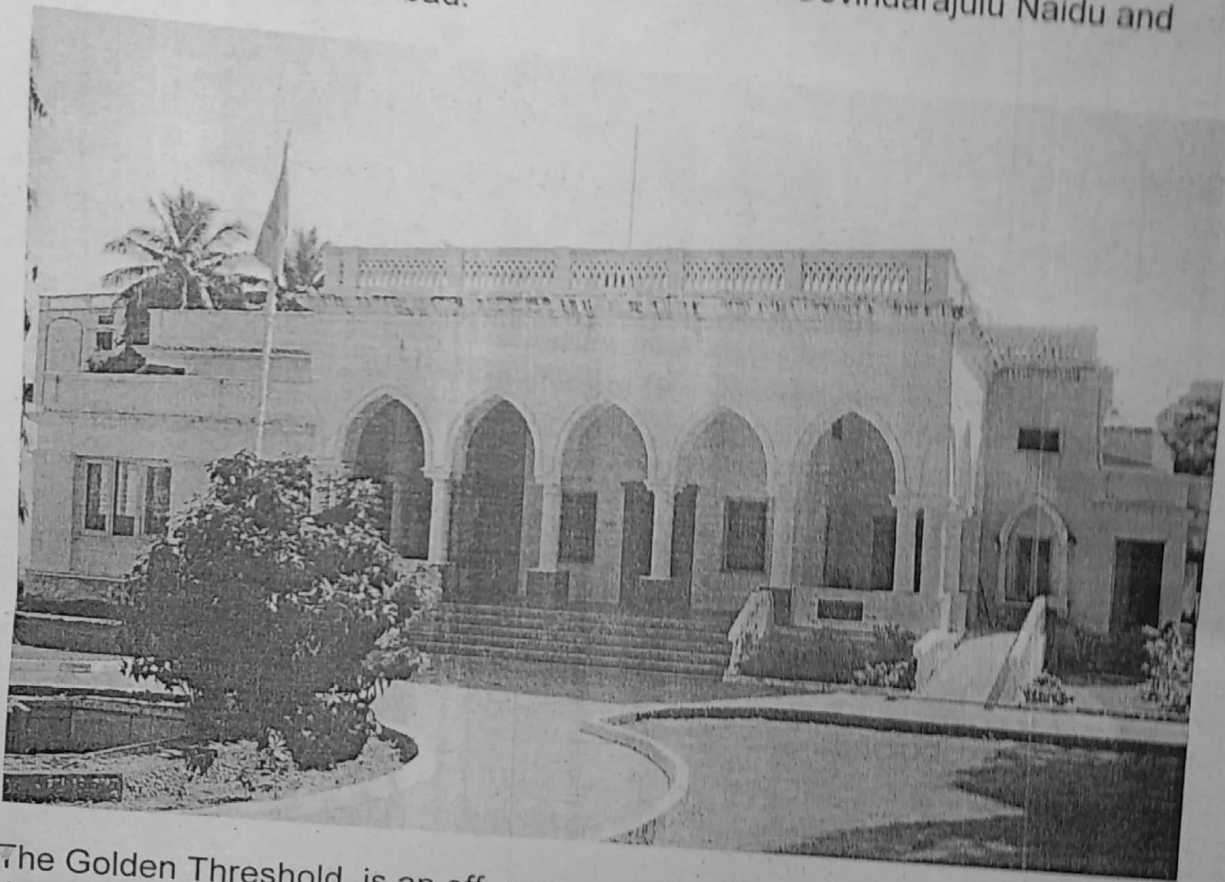
The Government of Punjab conceptualized a mega project in commemoration of the unparalleled sacrifices of Indian's & Punjabi's for independence of India. The project aimed at setting up an integrated memorial complex for the heroes of the freedom struggle.

The Memorial is aimed at disseminating knowledge about the rich cultural heritage of the State in the minds of youngsters. The site, which falls on the Jalandhar-Amritsar national highway, was carefully selected by the State Government keeping in mind it's easy accessibility to visitors and to add another tourist destination for those on their way to the Golden Temple. Punjab Freedom Movement Memorial Foundation was formed by the Government of Punjab for implementation of this project.

Sarojini Naidu or Nightingale of India or Bharat Kokila, the first Governor of Uttar Pradesh, after joining the freedom movement following the Partition of Bengal, she was one of the leading figures in the movement and became the first woman President of the Indian National Congress.

She was born on 13 February 1879 in Hyderabad, Hyderabad State, British India (now in Telangana, India) She married Dr. Govindarajulu Naidu and settled down in Hyderabad.



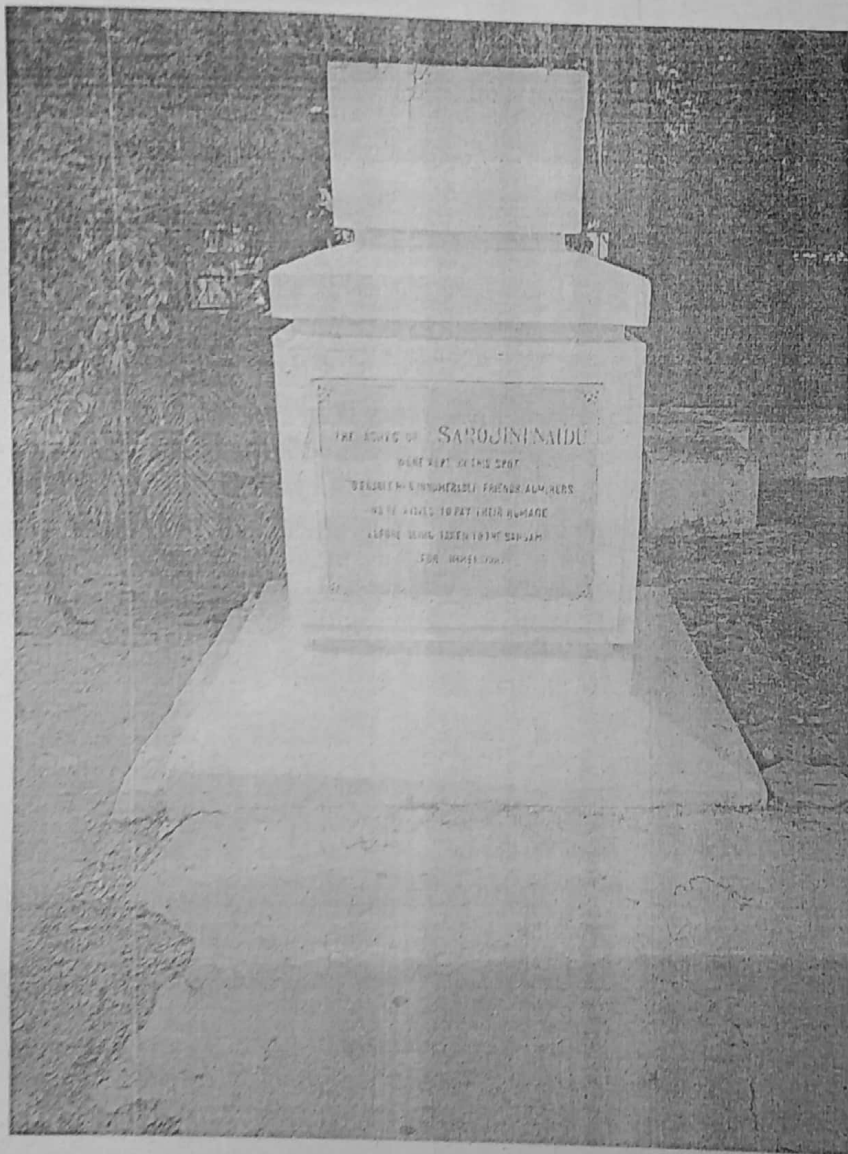
The Golden Threshold, is an off- campus annex of University of Hyderabad, the building was named after Naidu's very first collection of poetry, published in 1905.

It now houses Sarojini Naidu School of Arts & Communication of University of Hyderabad.

The building was the residence of Mrs.Sarojini Naidu's father Shri Aghornath Chattopadhyay, the first Principal of the Prestigious NIZAM College (<https://www.nizamcollege.ac.in/docs/darpan-proof-2015-16.pdf>).

The Chattopadhyay residence was a magnet of political discussions and reformist ideas, all of which influenced Sarojini greatly. Her ashes were brought to The Golden Threshold after her death to enable friends, admirers and relatives to pay their last respect before being immersed in the Sangam.
