SCHEME OF NATIONAL AWARDS FOR BRAVERY FOR CHILDREN (2021)

INTRODUCTION:

The Scheme of National Awards to Children for bravery was started 64 years ago in the year 1957. It was in this year that two children - a boy and a girl - were first rewarded for their exemplary presence of mind and courage. Since then, ICCW decided to confer National Awards to children, every year.

OBJECTIVES

The main objective of the scheme is to give due recognition to the children who perform acts of bravery with a view to inspire other children to follow their example. The deed should be "an act of spontaneous selfless service in the face of risk to life or threat of physical injury and/or an act of courage and daring against a social evil/crime".

PROCESSES INVOLVING APPLICATIONS

Wide publicity is given for the programme. Nominations are invited from all over India.

PROCESS OF APPLYING

Nominations are received in the prescribed application form which can be obtained from ICCW headquarters office or can be downloaded from ICCW's website. The application form should be recommended by two of the listed Competent Authorities. The form is to be accompanied by a write-up of about 250 words giving the details of the deed performed by the applicant, proof of date of birth, Newspaper/Magazine Clippings and the First Information Report (FIR) or Police Diary Filled with the Police Station. The account of the incident as well as supporting documents should preferably be endorsed by two of the listed Competent Authorities.

AGE LIMIT

The child should not be below 6 years and above 18 years of age on the date of the incident.

RECOMMENDING/COMPETENT AUTHORITIES

The application must be recommended by any two of the following:

1. Principal/Headmaster of the School in which the applicant is studying or Head of Panchayat/Zila Parishad
2. President, General Secretary of the State Council for Child Welfare.
3. Collector/DM/Govt. Official of equivalent rank.
4. Supdt. Of Police of the area or Police official of higher rank.

DATE OF INCIDENT

Incidents which have occurred between July 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021 will be considered for the 2021 awards. The Selection Committee, may at its discretion relax the date by a maximum period of six months prior to July 1, 2020 if it so deems fit. ICCW reserves the right to relax the date of the deed for a very deserving act for recognition.

DATE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

Last date of submission of application is, October 05, 2021.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

The selection is made by a high powered Committee constituted by ICCW.

Applications once rejected for whatever reason will not be entertained again.

The Selection Committee may at its discretion consider relaxation of any of the conditions/rules if it so deems fit.

Submission of application does not guarantee selection.

The decision of the selection Committee shall be final.

AWARD

The Award confers:

- A Medal (Gold, Silver).
- A certificate.
- Cash award.

The Awardees also receive various gifts from Philanthropic Organisations. The Award will be presented at New Delhi by an eminent and distinguished personality. The Awards details are given below:

3. Applications which are incomplete or not authenticated by the Competent Authorities or not supported by the relevant documents will not be entertained.
4. A write up of about 550 words giving the details of the deed performed by the applicant, either in English or Hindi should be attached separately, properly endorsed by the Competent Authorities recommending the application. Accounts of deeds or any other information/enclosures in the regional/local language should be accompanied by a translation in Hindi or English duly verified by the Competent Authorities.
5. The detailed description of the deed should clearly give the steps taken by the child performing the act. For example, in cases pertaining to drowning, the depth/width of the pond/river etc. must be mentioned. It should also be explicitly stated whether the applicant knows swimming or not. In other cases pertaining to rescue from fall, the height of the structure must be mentioned.
6. Competent Authority means the following:
 - a) Principal/Headmaster of the school in which the applicant is studying or Head of Panchayat/Zilla Parishad.
 - b) President/ General Secretary of the State Council for Child Welfare.
 - c) Collector/DM/Govt. Official of equivalent rank.
