Dear Sir/Madam,

Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters.

To celebrate World Environment Day on 05 June 2023 in collaboration with UNICEF, the Bharat Scouts and Guides issue a special 'Activity Pack' for the members of the organization. As members of our esteemed organization, we believe it is our responsibility to participate actively in the occasion to contribute to the preservation and conservation of our environment.

To mark this special day, we have planned a series of activities, packed with funand learning experiences. We encourage all our Cubs, Bulbuls, Scouts, Guides, Rovers, Rangers and Unit Leaders to participate wholeheartedly and make a difference through their actions.

The activities are as follows:

- Plastic Awareness Campaign: Create informative posters, banners, and pamphlets that highlight the harmful effects of plastic pollution on the environment. Conduct an awareness campaign in schools, markets, or public places to educate people about reducing plastic usage.
- Connect with nature: Visit the nearby garden, park or zoo and explore the 2. beauty of nature. Take pictures of nature, different animals and plants, species etc. and share them on your Social Media with their scientific name.
- Nukkad-Natak: Conduct nukkad-natak on saving the environment at prime locations like market areas, railway stations, bus stands etc. with your patrol or unit and create awareness among the public.
- Scavenger hunt: Learn about nature by walking around a park or other open spaces. Moreover, they can record nature without disturbing it. Some of the activities that they can perform are:
 - Drawing pictures of flowers and plants
 - Spotting birds
 - Collecting litter and throwing them into the dustbin
 - 4. Taking pictures or writing down the names of animals they spot

- 5. Grow plants with seed jars: Make a seed jar for this activity. Collect paper towels, a jar, and some seeds of your choice. For this activity, you can place the paper towel inside jars. Pour some water into the jar and put the seeds inside the jar. After a couple of weeks, you can see live plants growing inside the jar. After that, you will shift the plant to a flower pot or ground.
- Build an eco-friendly bird feeder: Build a bird feeder from cardboard or wooden ply to attract birds. Use string, scissors, bird seeds, bamboo skewer, and cardboard tubes to make a bird feeder and hang it.
- 7. Learn how to compost: Every household produces a lot of bio-waste. Use this bio-waste to learn to compost. This organic material can be added to plants to support their growth. Collect fruits and vegetable peels, eggshells, tea bags, newspapers, and other bio-waste to make compost. To perform this activity, require soil, a compost bin with a lid, and plant and kitchen waste.
- Plastic Waste Audit: Conduct a waste audit in your house, community or school to assess the amount of plastic waste generated in a week. Use the findings to raise awareness and implement effective waste management strategies.
- 9. Make a garden / Kitchen Garden/ Hanging Garden: Build garden, kitchen garden or hanging garden. Select the best plants for your garden. You can use glass or plastic bottles to make hanging gardens. It will help you to reuse the bottles.
- Clean-Up Drive: Join hands to clean up a nearby park, your school premises/garden or a public area. Collect and dispose of litter responsibly, promoting cleanliness and a sustainable environment.
- Tree Plantation: Conduct/Participate in a tree plantation drive, where each
 one will have the opportunity to plant a sapling, symbolizing their commitment
 to a greener future.
- 12. Campfire: Conduct a Campfire programme with unit members and the local community on the theme of "Save Environment" or "Climate Change". The campfire items like talks, skits, songs, recitations etc. to be conducted based on a theme.
- 13. Take a pledge: On Facebook Live take a group pledge with at least 10 friends/neighbors/community people:
