

## Office of the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Mansa. Order

In light of instructions contained in letter No. 7/56/2021/2H4/2069 dated 27.04.2021, issued by Additional Chief Secretary (Home) to Govt. of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Chandigarh and in continuation of this office letter No 6832-6854 /MC dated 20.04.2021, considering the COVID-19 situation in the District, additional restrictions are hereby imposed w.e.f. 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 till further orders:-

- 1. All shops including those in malls and multiplexes etc. to close everyday by 5.00 PM with home delivery allowed upto 9.00 PM.
- 2. Daily Night curfew (already in force from 8 PM to 5 AM) shall now be from 6 PM to 5 AM on all days prohibiting all the non-essential activities.
- 3. Week-end-curfew from 5.00 AM on Saturday upto 5 AM on Monday. However, all the essential activities shall remain exempted.
- 4. All private offices including service industry allowed to work from home only.

The following activities shall, subject however to observance of covid appropriate behaviour by all concerned, be exempted from Covid restrictions mentioned above.

- Chemist shops and shops dealing with supply of essential goods like milk, dairy products, vegetables, fruits etc.
- 6 Manufacturing industry.
  - Movement of employees/ labour of manufacturing industry and vehicles carrying them is allowed. However, concerned industry shall issue them requisite permission for the purpose.
  - 7 To and fro movement of passengers travelling via air, trains ,buses etc.
  - 8 Construction activities in both the Urban and Rural areas.
- Agricultural including procurement, horticultural, animal husbandry, veterinary services.
- 10 E-commerce and movement of all goods.
- Vaccination out-reach camps.

There shall be strict implementation of National Directives for COVID-19 Management guidelines, Standard Operating procedure (SOP) and advisories issued by MHA/State Government on Covid appropriate behaviour including social distancing norm of minimum 6 feet distance (2 Gaz Ki Doori), regulating crowds in market places and public transport and imposition of penalties prescribed for violation of Covid appropriate behaviour like wearing of face masks and spitting in public places etc.

Any violation of these guidelines shall be punishable under section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 besides legal action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC).
